HOSTING A POVERTY SIMULATION:

A business, group or organization may host a Poverty Simulation facilitated by United Way of Douglas & Pope Counties. Here are the logistics of hosting a Poverty Simulation:

- Time to promote the event and generate a confirmed participant list. (At least 45 days recommended.) We will also utilize this time to hold an orientation for volunteers who will help facilitate the simulation.
- Allow 2.5 3 hours for the event.
- A large, open room is required for the simulation (Roughly 3,500 sq ft.)
- 14 Tables, 185 chairs and a microphone are needed for the event. (Map provided)
- 30 80 Participants are needed
- 20 Volunteers are needed to facilitate the event (Volunteers will participate in simulation as different social services and agencies)
- UWDP will work with you to customize your debriefing period to ensure the simulation experience is valuable and applicable to your group.
- No cost

WHAT IS A POVERTY SIMULATION?

A Poverty Simulation is an interactive experience where participants take on different roles that place them into scenarios that low-income families face. The Poverty Simulation brings awareness to the realities of living in poverty. Roles are based off of real families. The goal of those participating in the simulation is to meet the needs of their family for one month. This is not a game.

The purpose of a Poverty Simulation is to raise awareness and increase understanding about what poverty looks like in our community. This allows us to better serve our community through addressing core needs residents have, so we can create real change locally.
