SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Tote (*for supplies!*)
- Car maintenance manual
- Spare mittens & hat
- Rain poncho
- Emergency space blanket
- Band aids & antibiotic cream
- Window scraper
- Small shovel
- Jumper cables
- “How to Jump a Car” printable
- Tow Truck/emergency phone numbers
- Ice Melt
- Tire pressure gauge
- Flashlight
- Hand Warmers
- Gas card
- Red cloth
- Matches
- Coffee can
- Candle or tea candles

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Purchase or collect new supplies.
2. Take the supplies and place them in the bin or tote. Print off instructions and emergency phone numbers.
3. Bring completed kits to the United Way to be distributed to agencies and clients who need them.
