

FOOD DROP FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a Food Drop?

A food drop is an opportunity for anyone who registers and attends to receive food.

Do I have to pay? How much is it?

No payment – the food drop is free for any household that registers!

How do I qualify?

You don't! The food drop is for any household. There is no income requirement, and no persons per household requirement. If you register, you will receive food.

How do I register?

Registration needs to be done online, or by calling our office 320-834-7800

What if I can't register? Can I show up and receive food?

No. We're sorry, but registration is the ONLY requirement to receive food. You must register during the registration period in order to receive food.

What if I don't have transportation or can't get to the church?

Please call our office to discuss your specific situation. 320-834-7800

What should I bring?

You don't have to bring anything. The food will be pre-bagged and placed in your vehicle.

What kind of food will be available?

We plan to have a mix of canned, boxed, and bagged shelf stable food, in addition to fresh or frozen food. The food available will vary.

Will you run out of food?

No! We never run out of food. Everyone who registers will receive food.
