Fishing Tournament Results

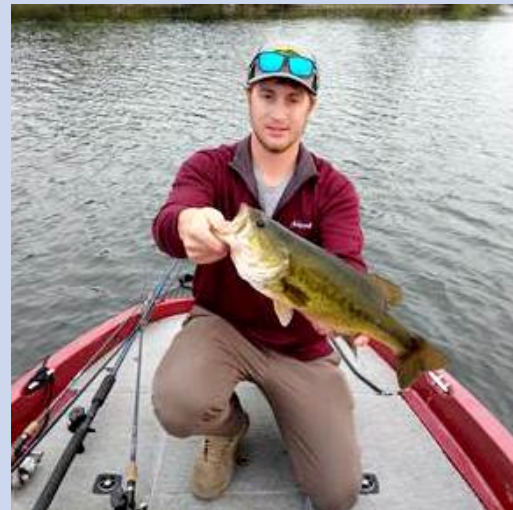
